Ever wondered what goes on at CRES and the Safari Park's state of the art veterinary center?

Who: Student in grades 6-12 and one parent chaperone are welcome.

What: Spatial Ecology module - Combine GPS technology, computer GIS software, animal ecology and critical thinking to help solve conservation challenges that threaten some of the world's most endangered species. The equipment will be handed out in the morning and students (chaperoned by their parent) will go into the Park and collect data. Then the students will bring the equipment back when they return for their lab at 1:00 p.m.

When: Friday, March 16th, 2012. Meet by 8:45 a.m.. Be sure to bring a lunch (or money for lunch) as you will want to eat lunch before your 1:00 p.m. lab.

Where: The Safari Park is at 15500 San Pasqual Valley Road, Escondido, California 92027-7017. Please meet at the Safari Park's main entrance (near guest relations).

Cost: FREE for students! Adults will pay \$10 (or bring annual pass if you have one!) Adult payment must be paid by check, payable to Dehesa Charter School.
